THE ANATOMY OF ADVANCEMENT



BASECAMP

(SCOUT, TENDERFOOT, SECOND CLASS, FIRST CLASS)

- Focus: Learning & Doing
- Pace: Self-paced (requirements worked on simultaneously)
- Key Metrics: 15+ outdoor activities (camping, hiking), basic first aid, physical fitness tests, active participation, and Scout spirit
- Administration: Scoutmaster Conferences (SMC) and Unit-level Boards of Review (BoR)



THE ASCENT

(STAR, LIFE, EAGLE)

- Focus: Leading & Mentoring
- Pace: Time-bound (4 to 6 months of strict active tenure required per rank)
- Key Metrics: Formal leadership positions (e.g., Patrol Leader, Quartermaster), teaching younger Scouts via EDGE method, complex service projects, heavy merit badge accumulation
- Administration: Formal references, detailed applications, and Council-level verification

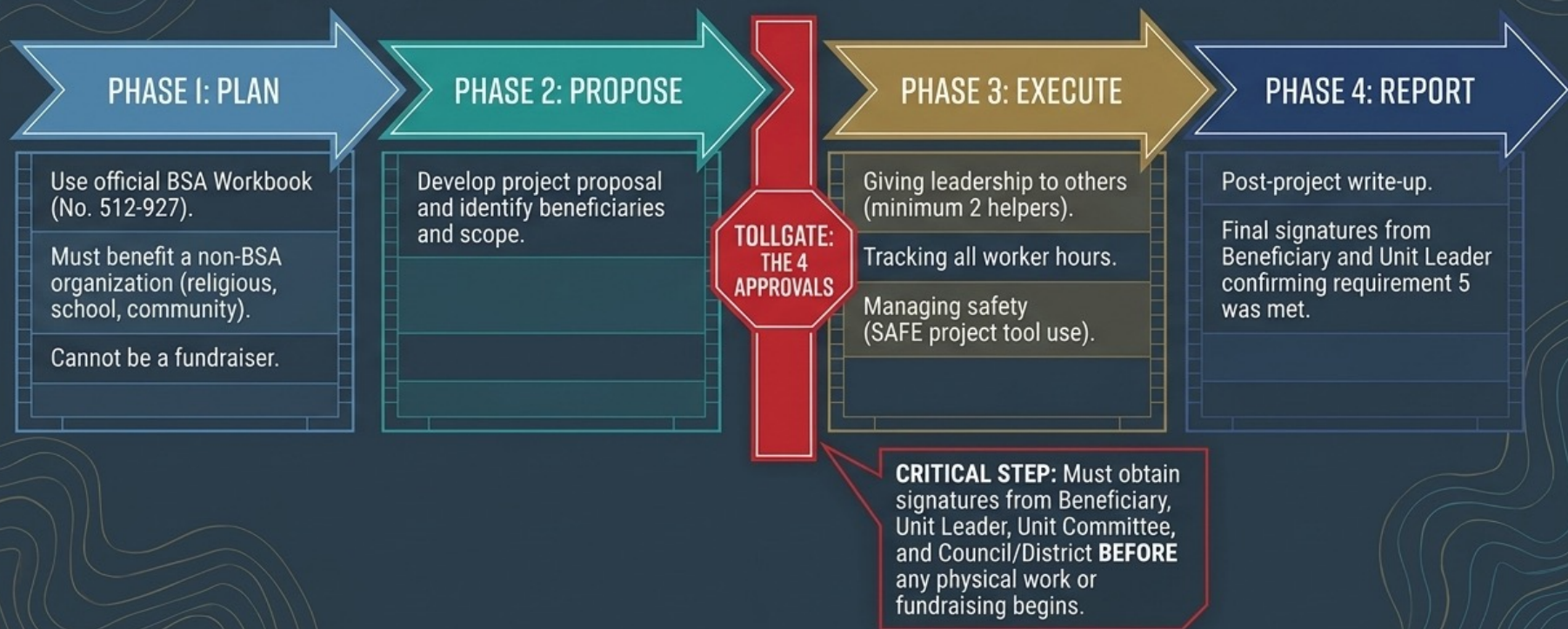

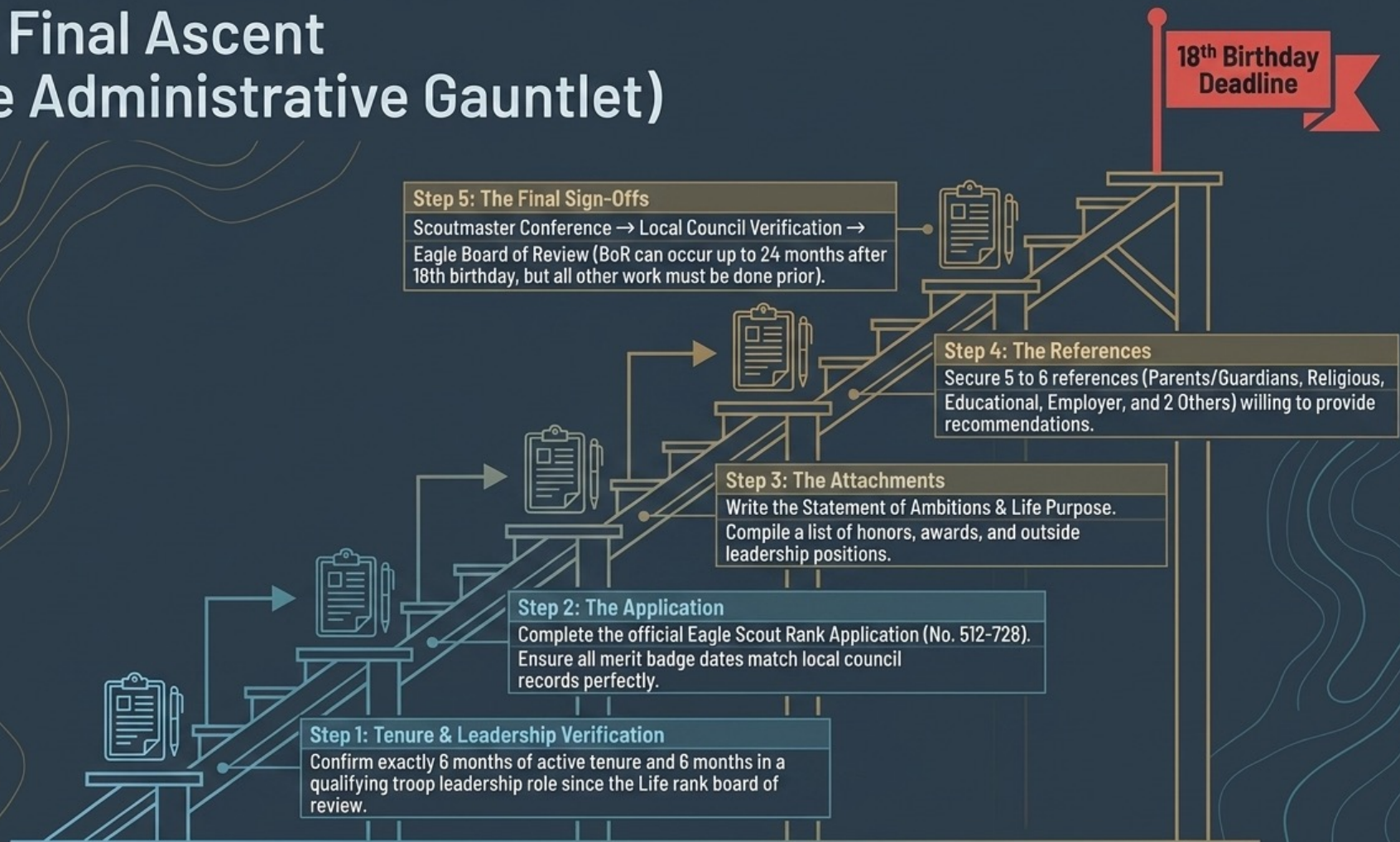
